## **BACKGROUND**

Edmonton Branch awards are disbursed following the guidelines outlined below, based on submissions from the teacher and/or the student. Please read the following information carefully as awards are determined according to the following criteria.

## **WHICH EXAM SESSIONS ARE INCLUDED?**

All examinations from **September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025** will be considered for awards. Please do not apply for awards for examinations outside of this date range.

## AWARDS AVAILABLE FOR PRACTICAL SUBJECTS

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM STANDARDS MUST BE ACHIEVED:

All Practical subjects Levels 1 to 10:	85%
Performers ARCT and Licentiate	80%
Junior, Intermediate Viva Voce	85%
Advanced Pedagogy Viva Voce	80%

**PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT MARKS THAT DO NOT MEET THESE MINIMUM STANDARDS!!**

In the event of ties each candidate will receive an award.

**\*\*NOTE:** You may also include results from split level exams as long as the latest exam falls within the eligible date. The sum of both partial exams of that level will be taken for the qualifying award mark.

To address the disparity in the number of candidates submitted for RCM compared with CC exams, as well as the much smaller candidate pool in disciplines other than piano, grades and instruments are grouped as follows:

## AWARDS AVAILABLE FOR THEORETICAL SUBJECTS

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM STANDARDS MUST BE ACHIEVED:

RCM Level 8 Theory OR CC Theory 3	90%
All other theoretical subjects (Harmony, History, Counterpoint, Analysis, Written Pedagogy)	80%

**PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT MARKS THAT DO NOT MEET THESE MINIMUM STANDARDS!!**

In the event of ties each candidate will receive an award.

RCM Level 5, Level 6, Level 7 Theory and CC Theory Grades 1-2 are NOT eligible for monetary awards; however, submissions for these levels that have achieved 90% will receive a Certificate of Achievement.
